CIRCULAR TO THE PARENTS OF CLASSES VI TO VIII CBSE READING CHALLENGE 2024-2025

Dear Parents,

Greetings from Indian School Muscat!

The Reading Challenge is organised by the CBSE as an initiative to inculcate a lifelong love of reading in students and enhancement of essential skills for their academic and personal development. Effective reading involves grasping the text's meaning, accurately interpreting information, connecting it with what is already known and reflecting on and evaluating the content to draw logical conclusions. The students of Middle Section, from classes VI to VIII are encouraged to take part in the Reading Challenge 2024-2025.

The Reading Challenge will be held during the months of August and September. The challenge will be conducted in both **Hindi** and **English**. Students are welcome to participate in either English, Hindi or both languages. The first round of the Reading Challenge will take place offline, conducted at the school level.

The students of class VI and VII will participate in category I, while class VIII students will compete in category II. Two students from each class will be selected for the second round for a computer- based Reading Challenge through CBSE Reading Challenge online portal.

All the participants of Round-II will be issued an online participation certificate by the Board. Outstanding performers will be awarded appreciation certificates. The results of Round Two winners will be notified on the CBSE Academic website.

Students interested in participating in the Reading Challenge should enroll by registering their names with their respective English or Hindi teachers. The last date for registration is August 14, 2024. The CBSE Reading Challenge presents an excellent opportunity to enhance literacy skills, critical thinking and instill a passion for reading with understanding. We encourage all the students of the Middle Section to embrace this opportunity and take part in the Reading Challenge, demonstrating their enthusiasm for reading and commitment to learning.
